

Friday: Long Distance, Pt. Douglas to Stillwater, Mn.


Wind 150*to180* @10-20kts. G25 max. WIND / WEATHER / BOAT Support permitting.

Saturday: Marathon, Pt. Douglas to Kinnikinic????

Wind Full Compass @ 3-35 kts. (rig small, stand tall, don't fall)

In light winds, from South. Plan on pumping, against current, to get to wind line.

Current can range from 1.8 kts. @ ramp to 4.8 kts. Under bridges on Wisconsin side@ normal pool elev. 675ft.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Rules The Tour da Croix will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (ISAF) 2017-2020

(RRS), (Appendix B) Windsurfing Competition, the Rules of the USW National Race

Tour, and the NoR. The class rules of the participation Classes (except any of those altered by

these Sailing Instructions), and these Sailing Instructions (SI) will take precedence.

2. Entries Notice to Competitors/Changes in the Sailing Instructions and Racing Schedule

To be an eligible competitor, the entry formalities shall be completed at registration.

Formalities are: Paying the required entry fee, fill out the registration form (Fleet,

Class, Sail number, Expiration Date / U.S. Windsurfing or U.S. Sailing and sign the wavier.

Any Notice to the Competitors or change in the Sailing Instructions will be signed by the Race Director and posted on the Official Notice board (ONB) located at the event site. Any change to the sailing Instructions (other than the Racing Schedules) will be posted before 0830 on the day it will take effect. Any change in the first scheduled Starting Times will be posted before 2000 hours (8 pm) on the day before it will take effect.

The following Flag Signals will be used:

Flag "AP" with two (2) sounds signals (one sound signal when lowered) means: "Races not started are postponed. The Warning Signal will be made not less than 30 minutes after "AP" is lowered".

3. The Courses Diagrams, the order in which Marks are to be passed,

and the side on which each Mark is to be left will be posted on the ONB at the skipper meeting.

4. Marks The course marks shall be described at the Skippers Meeting.

5. The Start

Races will be started as follows

Time	Sound Signals	Title	Visual Signals
5 min	1 short	Warnings	Class Flag
4 min	1 short	Preparatory	P, I, Z, or Black flag
1 min	1 short		P, I, Z Black flag removed
(0)	Long Blast	Starting	Class Flag removed

The starting line will be between the Starting Mark on the Port end and the RC boat located on the starboard end.

Rule 30.3 (Black Flag) shall apply from the first start.

- **6. Class Flags** See MOWind flag and staring sequence.
- 7. The Finish The finish line will be between the RC boat and the orange inflatable mark located off

shore from launch ramp. As indicated in the respective Course Diagrams.

The race will start at 10 a.m. (Wind and Weather Permitting)

And finish no later than 3 p.m. (5 hour maximum time limit)

8. Committee Boat Identification

Committee Boats will fly colored flags specified at the Skippers Meeting

9. Change of course after the start. The committee boat will fly the ('S') flag

10. Wind Minimum The minimum wind to start a race will be a constant 3 knots.

All wind speeds will be measured on shore or on the race committee boat. The race committee will be sole judge of wind speed and their decision is final.

11. Competition Format

The Tour da Croix will be a valid event with 1 race completed. If a race has to be postponed that race will be scheduled the next day, weather permitting. *Long Distance (wind 150-180' @ 15-25 kts.)*

12. Scoring will be by MOWind Guidelines

Course less than 30 minutes. Distance less than 1 hour. Long Distance / Marathon more than 1 hour. Example: 1st place finish time 2:18:56 = 5 courses

- **13. Equipment and Measurement checks.** All the boards should comply with class rules.
- **TV and Press Boats** Actions by the TV and Press boats shall not be ground for redress. Drivers appointed by the Organizing committee will drive these boats.

15. <u>Environment – Keep it clean, leave it better than when you arrived.</u>

Any competitor observed by a member of the events staff – Race Committee discarding trash on site or into the water may, after a hearing called in accordance with Rule 60.2 & Rule 60.3, penalized at the discretion of the Jury in accordance to statements to that effect in the Sl's.

Safety Prescriptions A competitor leaving the Racing Area before the end of the Race shall inform a Race Committee boat before leaving the Race Area or, when that is impossible, the check in point. Immediately after the arrival on shore.

Competitors not leaving the shore for a Race shall inform the Race Committee before the Start.

If any one of the signals Flag AP over A or AP over H or N over H is made on a Race committee boat, all competitors shall return ashore immediately.

- * Personal: PFDs' / foot protection advised! Shoreline is rocky...current can be strong 4+kts.
