**Venue**

South Higgins Lake State Park near Roscommon, Michigan. Phone: 989 821 6374. (305 acres, 512 campsites. Picnicking and boat launch. Wooded campground, sandy beach.) Roscommon Chamber of Commerce: (517) 275 8760. Directions: North on I-75 to Roscommon exit. Left at stop sign at the end of exit ramp, over overpass, right on Robinson Lake Road. Left at County Road 100. Follow this road to signs for park entrance.

**Possible Classes**

1. Novice: Any windsurfing gear.
2. Longboard Limited: Any longboard (with centerboard); 8.5 sail or smaller.
3. Formula (Modified): Any 1 shortboard (no centerboard) and any 3 sails, to be used for the duration of the regatta.
4. Prodigy (Hybrid) : Prodigy One-Design, or any hybrid (11 feet in length or shorter, with centerboard), and 9.5 sail or smaller.
5. Open: Any windsurfing gear.

Classes may be divided into Divisions by age, weight or sex. A minimum of four competitors may be required to form a class.
